## ***Manager Jonathan Stilwell wins crown in fifth season in league Otters win both halves. Take OAPBA pennant without a World Series***

**Jonathan Stilwell's Otters** (55-25), in their fifth season of operation, seized the OAPBA title in dominant fashion in 2015. The Otters took both halves of regular season play to win the 2015 OAPBA championship without having to face anyone in World Series play.



**Jonathan Stilwell's** Otters ran away with both halves to win their first-ever OAPBA championship in 2015.

The Otters cumulative season record of 55-25, .688 ranked as the seventh-best record in the league's 28-year history. Underscoring the dominance of the Otters in 2015, the Otters had a winning record against every one of their 2015 opponents. Only the Beefers and the Taz Devils were able to beat the Otters as many as six times in 16 games.

In the first half, The Furry Ones finished strong to run down Walt Taylor's perennially strong Whatever's (22-18), finishing five games in front of the Whats and seven games in front of Marc Bostrom's third-place Road Warriors (20-20).

Rod Caborn's Beefers got off to a surprisingly 12-4 start to take an early lead in the second half, but were overtaken by the Otters midway through the half. The Otters eventually won going away, finishing with an

outstanding 28-12 second half record, six games ahead of Walt Taylor's Whatever's (22-18) and seven games ahead of the Beefers (21-19)

Stilwell's Otters featured a deep starting rotation that went 40-17, 2.99, led by **Henderson Alvarez** (10-1, 2.20) and **Julie Teheran** (7-4, 2.19) and a monster bullpen that was a combined 15-8, 2.29, headlined by closer **Drew Storen** (3-1, 2.74, 12 saves) and middle relievers **Dan Jennings** (1.62) and **Bryan Morris** (1.39). Offensively, the Otters were led by CF **Mike Trout** (.263, 17 HR, 50 RBI), infielder **Anthony Rendon** (.235, league-leading 51 RBI), and 3b **Todd Frazier** (12 HR, 33 RBI).

### ***OAPBA contracts to six teams for 2015, league's 28<sup>th</sup> season.***

OAPBA launched its 28<sup>th</sup> season having to make significant changes. Following the disbanding of Steven Korb's Turfbeaters, the league contracted to six teams, The loss of Korb's team marked the second straight season that OAPBA had to shrink, with the Turfbeaters exit following the departure of Joe Passiatore's mighty Platoon II and Kris Stenger's Gashouse Gang after the 2013 season.

For 2015, the league adopted a two-half, 40-game season with the winners of each half meeting in the World Series. Stilwell's Otters, by virtue of winning both halves, won the championship outright.

As a result of the contraction, only the best pitchers in the majors were concentrated into the six teams. OAPBA offensive production clearly demonstrated the dominance of pitching, diminishing considerably with the pitchers having the upper hand all season long. Batting averages plunged and ERAs were miniscule as offenses, facing only the highest-ranked pitchers all season long, plunged.

In an effort to avoid the development of “super teams” that would suffer from a dominance of pitching, the league’s draft protocol was substantially altered, for 2015.

Each of the six teams drafted one of MLB’s six divisions, re-stocking their roster only from the teams from within the division drafted by the team. While well-intentioned, even the revised draft protocol failed to stimulate offenses, as evidenced by the reduced scoring that characterized the 2015 season.

***2015 Regular Season***

***First half: Otters roar from behind to catch Whats, take first half title***

**Walt Taylor’s Whatevers** grabbed the lead in the early going, starting 10-6 run, and starting the season by taking three of four from both Dave Mitchell’s Piranhas and the Beefers and then splitting with Dave Larson’s Taz Devils and the contending Otters.

At the first half mid-season mark, both the Otters and Whatevers were tied at 11-9. After winning three of four at home against the Piranhas, the Whats took a one-game lead over the Otters (13-11).

From that point forward, it was all Otters as Stilwell’s charges went 14-2 over the final sixteen games of the first half to outdistance the Whats by five games. The Otters swept two consecutive series in their run, shutting out the Beefers in two games of a four-game sweep and then sweeping the Whatevers in a critical series, holding the punishing What offense to only five runs in the four games.

The Whats, at 18-14, need to finish strong, but concluded the first half with splits against the Beefers and Road Warriors. The Otters meanwhile, won three in a row from the Taz Devils, before the Tazzie ended the Otters win streak at 11 games by a 3-1 score. The Otters finished off the first half by taking three of four from the Piranhas to finish 27-13, five games ahead of the Whats.

***Second half: Beefs fritter away early lead as Otters roar to second half crown***

**Rod Caborn’s Beefers** jumped out to an early lead in the second half, winning six of eight from the Dave Larson’s Taz Devils in a pair of series played in Chicago during SABR 2016. After a split with the Otters and a sweep of the Piranhas, the Beefers led the league at a surprising 12-4.



**Walt Taylor’s** Whatevers got off to a fast start in the first half, but the Otters ran them down with a 14-2 finish.



**Marc Bostrom's** Road Warriors had the least productive offense in OAPBA, but Bostrom was able to guide his team to a 41-39 finish.

Both the Otters and Whatevers started the second half at 11-5. After taking three of four from the Road Warriors, the Whats (14-6) took a one-game lead over the Otters the Beefers (both at 13-7).

At this point, the Otters launched a dramatic surge that propelled them to the league title. The Otters took three of four from the Taz Devils to improve to 16-8 while the Whats (15-9) and Beefers (15-9) fell a game behind.

With the league pennant now in sight, the Otters sprinted to a 12-4 finish,

including a three to one series win against the Whatevers, to finish 28-12. The Whats remained in range until their next-to-last series when they lost stunning four-game sweep to the Beefers, with the Whatever offense generating only four runs in the four losses.

The Otters strong 14-6 finish down the stretch in the second half put them well ahead of the determined Whatevers, who suffered through losing streaks of six games and five games, going 8-12 during the same stretch.

Following the end of the season, Piranhas manager **Dave Mitchell**, right, announced his retirement from the league. Dave's Titans, later the Piranhas, struggled to get on the winning side of the ledger during their tenure in the league, but Dave has been a well-liked and respected manager and his presence in the league will be missed.



**Dave Mitchell** led the Piranhas to the playoffs in 2005 and 2006.

***Otters Mike Trout and Henderson Alvarez head OAPBA All Star team for 2015***

Led by four members of the champion Otters, there was an all new look to the OAPBA All Star team in 2015. With the exception of Whatever RF **Giancarlo Stanton**, who was the All Star RF in 2013, every member of the the 2015 team was a first-time pick. Seven of the All Stars were unanimous selections.

Leading the voting was CF **Mike Trout**, a unanimous selection as the league's top center fielder and league MVP. Otter ace **Henderson Alvarez**, who went 10-1 to emerge as the league's top winner, was voted the Cy Young award. Devils long man **Delin Betances** won Reliever of the Year honors.

The other Otters named to the All Star squad were 13-year OAPBA veteran SS **Jimmy Rollins** and 2b **Anthony Rendon**, who led the league in RBIs.

**Mike Trout** gathered all the first place votes for both CF on the team and as league MVP. Trout led the league in total bases (164), triples (6), and runs scored (49). Trout finished second base hits (77) to All-Star C **Buster Posey**, who had 78 hits, and was third in doubles (24) and home runs (17).



**Righty Henderson Alvarez** was the league's top winner at 10-1 and had the lowest ERA in the league at 2.20.

**Henderson Alvarez** was the mainstay of the Otter pitching staff and the only 10-game winner in the league in 2015. Road Warrior ace Felix Hernandez finished second in the balloting with Clayton Kershaw finishing third and Johnny Cueto fourth.

Road Warriors 1b **Anthony Rizzo** was the first choice at his position followed by Adrian Gonzalez, Freddy Freeman, Miguel Cabrera, and Paul Goldschmidt.

Otters 2b **Anthony Rendon** powered his way to a unanimous selection ahead of challengers Robinson Cano, Jose Altuve, and Chase Utley. Longtime OAPBA SS **Jimmy Rollins**, who excelled for the Otters in

2015, out-pollled Jose Reyes, Alcides Escobar, and Troy Tulowitzki, as the All Star SS.

Another unanimous selection was Whatever 3b **Kyle Seager**, who finished ahead of Josh Donaldson, Todd Frazier, and Adrian Beltre.

League batting champ, Beefer **Corey Dickerson** got the most points in the voting for top LF. Mickey Brantley, Matt Kemp, and Christian Yelich finished behind Dickerson in that order. In CF, **Mike Trout** was a unanimous selection and was selected the MVP. Whatever slugger **Giancarlo Stanton**, the league's HR leader, was unanimously selected as the all-star right fielder. Matt Kemp, Jason Werth, Torii Hunter, and Christian Yelich finished second thru fourth in the voting.

Devils C **Buster Posey** received all the top votes as the league's best catcher. Jonathan Lucroy finished a distant second with Salvator Perez and Yan Gomes at third and fourth. Beefer utility man, **Justin Turner** was named as the league's Mr. Versatility. Yadier Molina, Wilson Ramos, Martin Prado, and Matt Kemp also got votes.

**Delin Betances** of the Devils, earned the most points as the league's top reliever. Joe Smith, Joaquin Benoit, and Andrew Miller finished second thru fourth in the balloting.

## 2015 OAPBA Draft

### ***Piranhas draft #1 for fourth straight season; selects P Cory Kluber with top pick***

The 2015 draft was conducted on a divisional draft bases, with each team drafting an MLB Division and supplementing their roster only from players within their division. Trades, of course, were permitted between teams, enabling managers a second means of augmenting and improving their rosters.

The draft was conducted without the usual group gathering to select individual players, the first time in the league's 28-year history that the traditional Draft Day was not conducted with all managers at the same place at the same time. Included in the draft were players that were previously on Steven Korb's Turfbeaters, who were disbanded after the 2014 season.



Righthander **Cory Kluber** was selected by the Piranhas as the top pick in the 2015 draft.

## *Inside the numbers*

### **Otters**

The Otters not only won the 2015 championship, but missed a Triple Crown in all three primary categories by a single error. The Otters led the league in batting, pitching, and committed only one more error than Marc Bostrom's Road Warriors, who won the fielding title.

The Otters hit .231 as a team, eleven points better than the Taz Devils, who hit .220 to finish second in team batting. The league champs also scored 328 runs as a team, outdistancing the Whatever's, who were runners-up in both halves, by 52 runs.

Led by 2015 MVP **Mike Trout**, with 19 HRs, the Otters hit 81 round-trippers, second in the league to the Road Warriors, who had 84 home runs. 2b **Anthony Rendon** led the league in RBIs with 51 and hit 12 HR just beating Trout, who drove in 50 runs. 3b **Todd Frazier** only hit .199, but drove in 33 runs with 12 HR. As a team, the Otter

SS **Jimmy Rollins**, an All-Star for the first time in his 13<sup>th</sup> OAPBA campaign, hit nine HR and hit .233.

The Otters mound corps was also the best in the league, led by Cy Young winner **Henderson Alvarez** (10-1, .220), who paced the league in wins and ERA. The Otter starting corps had a league-leading 2.99 ERA and was 40-17. **Julio Teheran** (7-4, 3.19) stood out while starters **Tanner Roark**, **Doug Fister** and **Jacob DeGrom** each had five wins. Stephen Strasburg was 5-4.

A deep relief corps was led long men **Bryan Morris** (1.39, 51 IP) and **Dan Jennings** (1.62 ERA) while **Drew Storen** had 12 saves and **Santiago Casilla** and **Ken Giles** each saved eight games.

### **Whatever's**

The Whats, paced by All-Star slugger **Giancarlo Stanton**, led the league in HRs (88), but were not able to generate more an average output, hitting only .218 as a team, identical to the total league average.

The Whatever team ERA of 2.87 was outstanding, but was only third in the league, underscoring just how difficult it was to score runs. Among starters, **Jon Lester** (7-4, 3.40) was the Whats leader in wins. **Adam Wainwright** had a sparkling 2.33 ERA, but suffered from a lack of support, going 6-10. Both Lester and Wainwright threw three shutouts each. Draftee **Matt Shoemaker** was 5-3, 2.07

The What bullpen had a collective 1.88 ERA with Joe Smith leading the way with a miniscule 1.14 ERA in a league-leading 36 appearances. Besides Smith, **Fernando Abad** (1.80), **Huston Street** (2.38), **Matt Thornton** (2.28), and **Dominic Leone** (2.44), all were outstanding.

In addition to the long-ball heroics of Stanton, 3b **Kyle Seager** was a Whatever standout, earning All Star honors at 3b, hitting .284 and slamming 12 HR while driving in 33 runs. Longtime OAPBA stalwart **Miguel Cabrera** hit 27 doubles to lead the league, while CF **Adam Jones** (.222, 13 HR, 37 RBI) was productive.

## **Road Warriors**

The Road Warriors had an abysmal offense, hitting only .203 but offset the lack of batting averages with an un-Roadie like 84 HRs, second in the league, and while shining on defense, committing only 27 errors to pace OAPBA and rise to third place.

1b **Anthony Rizzo** (.257, 19 HR, 38 RBI) made a fine debut for the Road Warriors while newcomer **Carlos Gomez** (.246, 13 HR, 24 RBI, 18 SB) hit well and was outstanding in CF. SS **Troy Tulowitzki** hit 10 HR in only 155 AB. The Road

Hard-luck **Felix Hernandez** (7-8, 2.25) and **Madison Bumgarner** (5-4, 2.18) were starting mainstays while **Lance Lynn** (7-6, 3.69) was the only Road Warrior starter to get much batting support. Longtime Roadie ace **Jered Weaver** fell off to 6-7, 3.95.

The Warrior bullpen, normally a strength, was fifth in the league with a collective 3.11 ERA. Closer **Greg Holland** (3-1, 3.09) was second in the league with 13 saves.

## **Beefers**

The 2014 champion Beefers returned to reality in 2015, dropping below .500 at 38-42, with the offense and defense both dropping sharply. The Beefs had a miserable 17-23 first half, but rebounded for 21-19 in the second half.

The Beefs only hit .216 as a team and frequently went into mysterious slumps with the team leading the league by getting shut out 12 times. The defense was sloppy, with 63 errors, contributing to 25 unearned runs.

The Beefer pitching (2.98) was outstanding with **Johnny Cueto** (6-5, 2.98), **Cole Hamels** (4-4, 2.93) and hard-luck **Max Scherzer** (6-8, 3.30) all having good seasons and newcomer **Hyu-Ju Ryu** surprising with a second half showing of 4-1, 1.14 ERA. Closer **Joaquin Benoit** (0-0, 1.23) led the league in save with 14. Lefty **Tony Watson** (2-2, 1.43) was solid in the middle and late innings.

The entire Beefer offense centered around All Starts LF **Corey Dickerson** and IF **Justin Turner**, who finished one-two in batting at .310 and .295 respectively. CF **Andrew McCutchen** was great on defense, but slumped to .234, but hit 11 HR and drove in 35 runs. Longtime Beef 1b **Adrian Gonzalez** had 33 RBIs.

## **Taz Devils**

The Tazzies finished second in batting, second in pitching...and fifth in the standings with an unremarkable 35-45 record.

It was a season of frustration for the Devils, who ranked next to last in HRs with 60 and whose pitching excelled, but suffered

**C Buster Posey** made the All Star team, hitting .280 and leading the league in hits with 78 base knocks. OF **Matt Kemp** hit 14 HR to lead the team and drove in 46 runs, joining Posey and 3b **Josh Donaldson** (.205, 12 HR, 23 HR), was an offensive leaders. 1b **Paul Goldschmidt**, counted on to be a powerhouse, hit only .243 and saw his power output drop to only three HR. 2b **Jose Altuve** was a bright spot, leading the league in SB with 37 and scoring 43 runs.

Lefty **Clayton Kershaw** (8-3, 2.26, 86 Ks) once again excelled while fellow southpaw **Chris Sale** was 6-7, 2.98 with 102 strikeouts. Reliever **Delin Betances** (1-3, 1.04, 7 saves, with 91 Ks in 69 innings) was the league's Reliever of the Year

### **Piranhas**

The Piranhas suffered through their fourth straight last-place finish, going 27-53 with manager **Dave Mitchell** announcing at season's end that he was temporarily calling it quits for awhile, possibly returning in a couple of years.

As the Titans, the team had a second place finish in the Harry Caray Division (39-45) in 2010. Changing the name to the Piranhas in 2011, however, did not change the team's fortunes, finishing in last place in the three-team Harry Caray Division in 2011 through 2013 and last in OAPBA in 2014 and 2015, compiling a 108-200, .318 record over the last four seasons.

The Piranhas were dead last in home runs in 2015 with 43, seventeen behind the Taz Devils, who were fifth in HRs with 60. The Piranhas pitching also suffered, finishing last in ERA at 3.67 while giving up a league high 319 runs.

2b **Robinson Cano** hit .269 and drove in 28 runs while 1b Justin **Morneau** hit .255 and led the team in RBIs with 33. C **Jonathan Lucroy** hit .242 and led the team in HRs with nine.

First round draft pick **Cory Kluber** fizzled, going 2-12, 4.07 to lead the league in losses while **Tyson Ross** (5-9, 4.76) led the league with 20 HRs allowed and gave up the most hits and runs in OAPBA. **James Shields** (5-10, 3.78) pitched valiantly, but were plagued by lack of offensive support. **Kyle Crockett** (0-2, 1.69) and closer **Wade Davis** (0-3, 1.09, 9 saves) pitched well, but gave up in opportune runs at the wrong moment, failing to record a win.

### **2015 Notes**

Whatever lefty **Jon Lester** shut out the Beefers twice in the first half, throwing a 6-0 five-hitter and a 5-0 four-hitter, striking out 11, with **Kyle Seager** providing two HRs in the second win. Whatever righty **Adam Wainwright** also shut out the Beefers two times during 2015, throwing hit 2-0 two-hitter in the first half and 3-0, two-hitter with 9 Ks in the second half.

Piranhas righty **Tyson Ross** struck out 12 Beefers in a 7-5 loss in the first half. Unfortunately for Ross, who led the league with 20 HR allowed, he gave up a pair of home runs to Beefer LF **Corey Dickerson** and a solo shot to C **Yan Gomes**.

Dickerson also hit two home runs in one game against Otters righty **Tanner Roark**, in an 11-4 win.

The Otters pounded out eight extra base hits in an 11-4 win against the Beefers in the first half, including HRs by **Mike Trout** and **Jimmy Rollins**. They followed with another six extra base hits in a 9-2 win over the Beefers in the first half, including a 3R HR by **Anthony Rendon**, a 2R HR by **Khris Davis**, plus four doubles.

Taz Devils LF **Matt Kemp** hit a 3R HR and 2R HR, driving in five runs, but it went for naught as the Devils dropped a 7-6 decision to the Beefers in a game played in the Palmer House in Chicago at SABR 2015.

**The Beefers scored nine runs in the top of the 13<sup>th</sup> inning** to beat the Piranhas 13-4 in a second half game. Thirteen batters went to the plate in the long inning, the highlight being a 3R HR by **Adrian Gonzalez**. Beleaguered Piranha reliever **Tyler Clippard** gave up all nine runs.

In the second longest game in the league in 2015, the WhatEVERS beat the Beefers 4-3 in 17 innings. SS **Andrelton Simmons** doubled home Kyle Seager in the top of the 17<sup>th</sup> to defeat lefty reliever **Jeremy Affeldt**.

The Beefers surprise the WhatEVERS with a late second half sweep, allowing only four runs and a total of 21 hits in the four games, highlighted by an 8-0 one-hitter in the opener by **Hyun-Jun Ryu**. The sweep ended the WhatEVERS chances of catching the Otters.

**Devils RF Matt Kemp hit two three-run HRs in one game on two occasions**, one against the WhatEVERS and once against the Piranhas. The Piranhas, after Kemp's outburst, won the next game, a 15-inning affair when Kemp made an error in the 15<sup>th</sup> with two out, giving the Fish the victory.

Beefers **Hisashi Iwakuma** beat the Devils 6-4 but all the Tazzie runs came after the hurler made an error with two outs.

Devil southpaw **Chris Sale** fanned 14 Road Warriors, benefiting from four homers from the offense including two by Josh Donaldson, and one each from Buster Posey and Matt Kemp. The Road Warriors **Felix Hernandez** followed that game by fanning 10 Devils in seven innings but losing 7-3. The Roadies then allowed the Devils 11 hits while generating only four hits themselves, but winning 4-3 in the 10<sup>th</sup> inning when Troy Tulowitzki beat the Devils with his third double of the game (all three doubles were home runs that were knocked down). King then followed up by fanning 13 Tazzies in a 1-0 shutout.



Three Devils pitchers struck out 13 Beefers in a 4-2 victory. Four Beefers hurlers responded in the next game by fanning 14 Devils, but losing 3-2.

The Otters and Devils traded back-to-back 2-1 games.

Devils southpaw **Clayton Kershaw** won battle of three-hitters against the Beefers **Hyun-Ju Ryu** as the Tazzies top the Beefers 1-0 to give Ryu (4-1) his only loss of the season. In another excellent outing, Kershaw fanned 10 Road Warriors in just six innings.



Road Warrior **C Jason Castro** drove in five runs in a 7-6 first half win against the Beefers. Castro hit a 3R HR and 2R double

WhatEVERS righty **Matt Shoemaker** beat the Tazzies 7-0 with a two-hitter.

Piranha pitchers walked seven Devils in a 7-3 loss.

Devils reliever **Darren O'Day** made two errors in two innings of work against the Whatever, both off the bat of Whatever **SS Jose Reyes**.

Four Otter pitchers struck out 15 Devils, but lost 4-1.

Road Warrior hitters drew seven walks, pounded out 11 hits, had a batter reach on an error, and another hit by a pitch. But it took an **Anthony Rizzo** RBI double in the 15th inning for the Roadies to beat the Devils 2-1.

Road Warrior Lance Lynn benefited from four first-inning runs while throwing a 4-0, three-hit out against the Devils.

The Whatevers had their walking shoes on in a 6-5 win over the Devils, **drawing eight free passes**.



The Devils **Sonny Gray** threw a one-hitter against the Beefs, winning 5-1, allowing only a fourth-inning RBI double by Beefer 2b **Chase Utley**.



Piranhas 1b **Justin Morneau** had four hits in a game against the Devils, but Morneau's efforts failed to help the Fish, who lost 5-2.
